Fresh, local, organic vegetables, eggs, yogurt & fruit!

Join a CSA that will bring fresh, organic vegetables from Crawford Organics Farm in New Holland, PA to the local community on a weekly basis! Sign up today!

**What is a CSA?** CSA stands for “Community Supported Agriculture” and refers to a system where people buy farm shares directly from the farmer and receive a weekly share of the harvest during the growing season.

**How does it work?** CSA members pay a lump sum fee at the beginning of the season and in turn receive fresh produce weekly at the designated CSA pick up location.

**What kind of produce?** Crawford Organics CSA shares include a wide variety of organically grown produce including lettuce, spinach, kale, broccoli, cabbage, carrots, cilantro, onions, peas, peppers, popcorn, potatoes, radishes, sweet potatoes, zucchini, sweet corn, etc. A full list of harvest expectations can be found on their website.

Eggs & Yogurt are available as add-on shares.

Low Spray Fruit is also available as an add-on or standalone share.

**What does it cost?** A spring/summer share (May-August) share costs \$684 (18 weeks) and a bi-weekly share is \$342 (9 deliveries). A mini size share costs \$486 for weekly delivery and \$243 for bi-weekly delivery.
